# **CHAMPAGNE**



#### Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial

1800

Region: Champagne

Notes: Vibrant intensity of green apple and citrus fruit, notes of brioche, cereal and fresh nuts, pear, peach and apple on the palate, citrus fruit and gooseberry.



## **Moët & Chandon Nectar Impérial**

2100

Region: Champagne

Notes: Nectar Impérial's assemblage is built on the structure of Pinot Noir (40% to 50%), the flesh of Pinot Meunier and the freshness of Chardonnay (10% to 20%). The use of 20% to 30% of carefully selected reserve wines.



#### **Veuve Clicquot Brut Yellow Label**

2100

Region: Champagne

Notes: The Veuve Clicquot Brut Is a blend of between 50 to 60 different crus, made of pinot noir (50%), meunier (20%) and chardonnay (30%), this champagne is aged for 36 Month.



#### **Veuve Clicquot Rich Collection**

3000

Region: Champagne

Notes: The Rich blend is comprised of Pinot Noir (50%), the main pillar of Veuve Clicquot's winemaking, which gives the champagne its fundamental structure; the large part of Meunier (30%) provides roundness to the blend; and Chardonnay (20%) completes it with extra freshness. Bottled at 12%.

# MCC/SPARKLING



Pierre Jourdan Brut 350

Region: Franschhoek

Notes: Created in the traditional French method of bottle fermentation known as Cap Classique in South Africa. Enjoy delicate yeasty aromas on the nose, complemented by fresh citrus flavors and crisp acidity.



#### **Alvis Drift Brut Cap Classique**

450

Region: Breede River Valley

Notes: Youthful in character with a refreshing bouquet of citrus, creamy lemon and just a hint of almond, this refined sparkling wine boasts a vibrant, finely textured mousse.



L'Ormarins Brut 470

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Fine bead and string of pearl bubbles. Aromas of tarte tartin, apple and cinnamon with a light pear drop and biscuit nuance. Bright vivacious and crisply zesty in the mouth. Tangy lime and green apple crunch with a richer, deeper, biscuit and sourdough undertone.



Villiera Tradition Brut 530

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Fresh racy zestiness as a result of crisp acidity and rich citrus fruit flavors, mellowed by flavors of brioche.



De Grendel Brut 560

Region: Durbanville

Notes: Bright straw yellow in color, with extremely fine streams of bubbles that carry wafts of biscuity richness to the nose, nuanced by fresh citrus aromas with hints of grapefruit peel.



#### **Villiera Tradition Brut Rosé**

520

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Combination of chardonnay, pinot noir and pinotage rich in flavor with a long finish.



## Pierre Jourdan Belle Rose Cap Classique

450

Region: Haute Cabriere

Notes: Created in the traditional French method of bottle fermentation known as Cap Classique in South Africa. Enjoy a full nose of strawberries and cream, followed by fresh acidity and red fruit on the palate.

#### Like Father Like Son Rose

160

Region: Breede River Valley

Notes: Loaded with strawberries, red berries and candyfloss. Easy drinking and perfectly balanced filled with flavors of fresh strawberries and soft tones of candyfloss. Excellent with light meals such as chicken or fish or as a summer wine on its own.



#### **Jordan Chameleon Dry Rose**

175

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Plummy merlot combined with summer-berry flavors of shiraz add complexity to this dry fruity wine.



#### **Saronsberg Provenance Shiraz Rose**

180

Region: Tulbagh

Notes: Rose petal color with plum, red berry and cherry flavors mouth feel is well balanced with a fresh

finish.



#### **Rickety Bridge Foundation Stone Rose**

450

Region: Franschhoek

Notes: An appealing light salmon pink with a delicate expression on the nose of citrus notes and hints of red berries. On the palate crisp freshness combines seamlessly with classis richness and finishes with finesse. Fine continuous mousse kisses the palate and lifts the wine to a long, elegant finish.

# **Laborie Sauvignon Blanc**

215

Region: Western Cape

Notes: This layered Sauvignon Blanc shows prominent aromas of guava and tropical fruit, with hints of cut grass. The fresh and zesty palate is well balanced with a linear acidity and fruity finish.



# Klein Constantia Sauvignon Blanc

230

Region: Contantia

Notes: Crisp minerality, fresh acidity; flavors of papaya, sweet melon, lemon, lime, and passion fruit. Long and rich finish.



# **Bruce Jack Sauvignon Blanc**

240

Region: Western Cape

Notes: Intense crunchy green apple and lemon grass. The riper components provide juicy white peach and touch of citrus.



# **Newton Johnson Sauvignon Blanc**

260

Region: Hemel en Aarde Valley

Notes: Fine, crystalline character with traces of flint. Old world complexity with delicate quince fruit and white asparagus, with wafts of perfumed autumn fynbos and withering flower petals. A dense sheet of texture with weight and persistence, gripping the palate into a lengthy finish.



## **Lanzerac Sauvignon Blanc**

265

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: This crisp and refreshing Sauvignon Blanc boasts generous aromas of green fruits including Granny Smith apples that interplay with white fruits such as Asian pears and white peaches in a perfect fruit-acid balance. A fresh lemongrass mouthfeel with subtle minerality is rounded off by a soft creaminess in the long finish due to extended lees contact.



# **DeLaire Graff Sauvignon Blanc**

290

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Our Coastal Cuvée is rich in tropical fruit flavors, underpinned by layers of blackcurrant, gooseberry and nettles. Well balanced and complex, it finishes long, with concentrated fruit and fresh, crisp acidity.



## **Meinert La Barry Sauvignon Blanc**

290

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Fresh and crispy with light tropical fruit flavors. Citrus on the palate, along with lime, green pepper and asparagus. Light acidity and a silky refreshing finish.



# **Muldersbosch Sauvignon Blanc**

310

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Juicy tropical guava, ripe lemons and blackcurrant. Some herbal fynbos notes – lavender, thyme and Origanum all packed into one. Extremely inviting and vivid!



## **Springfield Life from Stone Sauvignon Blanc**

310

Region: Robertson

Notes: Flinty, mineral character true to the quartz rock in which it is grown.



# **Strandveld Adamastor Sauvignon Blanc**

500

Region: Cape Agulhas

Notes: Typical Elim minerality and fynbos characters with citrus and white stone fruit. Full and creamy on the palate, with a combination of toasted oak flavors and a dry minerality on the aftertaste.



### **Eikendal Sauvignon Blanc**

535

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Has a beautiful light-yellow color and boasts a tropical palate. Hints of green apple and stone fruit on the nose which follows through to the palate. Crisp acidity with a full mouthfeel and a lengthy finish.

### **Saxenburg Guineafowl Chenin**

165

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Alluring array of tropical fruit, peach and pear aromas on the nose. These follow through to the palate and is beautifully balanced by a fresh, green apple-like acidity.



#### **Badenhorst Wines Secateurs**

215

Region: Swartland

Notes: Flinty aromas with honey, orange blossom and white stone fruit notes.



### **Rickety Bridge Chenin Blanc**

220

Region: Franschhoek

Notes: Inviting aromas of guava and white peach with underlying floral and green fig notes. A full, rich palate of tropical fruit, citrus and spice leads into a long-honeyed finish.

# Chardonnay



# **Glenelly Chardonnay**

260

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: The chardonnay displays a wonderful bright crisp color, with vibrant citrus, lime zest and hints of butterscotch on the nose. The palate is lush and the creamy texture is underpinned with beautiful mineral notes of toasted almond and vanilla. The finish is fresh with great minerality and with a nervous energy about it.



# **Warwick The First Lady Chardonnay**

285

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Un-oaked; intense nose of fresh pineapple, lemon, citrus and floral notes; mid-palate is broad and appealing supported by a lingering acidity; un-wooded.



# **Vriesenhof Unwooded Chardonnay**

300

Region: Stellnbosch

Notes: Bright, green-gold in appearance. Classic Chardonnay aromas of citrus and ripe apple combine seamlessly with creamy lees notes. Bracing and mineral in style.



# De Morgenzon DMZ

335

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Shows sweet vanilla and hints of almonds on the nose with a clean tropical fruit finish, delicate oak and full fruit flavor in the mouth with layers of white peach, apricot, grapefruit and vanilla.



# **Vriesenhof Chardonnay**

395

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: A boldly structured Chardonnay from mature vines, straw-golden in appearance.

Classic Chardonnay aromas of peaches & citrus blossom are complemented by vanilla pod and subtle

oaky notes.



# **Thelema Chardonnay**

425

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Aromas of ripe peach, grapefruit marmalade, blossoms and complex yeasty flavors complement the toasty oak in the wine.



# **Vondeling Chardonnay**

450

Region: Paarl

Notes: The wine has a bright hue with a golden straw color. It displays a refreshing nose of bright pear and peach blossoms with subtle lemon meringue and notes of freshly rolled oats.

#### **Rickety Bridge Foundation Stone White**

255

Region: Franschoek

Notes: All five varietals contribute to this complete and well-balanced wine: spring blossoms, peach, mango and stone fruit on the nose; subtle hints of oak spice; finishes with elegance and freshness on the palate.



#### **Diemersdal Grüner Veltliner**

295

Region: Durbanville

Notes: A lemon-lime color, inviting aromas of kiwi, stone fruit and lime with sweet melon, ripe pear and white pepper note. A medium bodied wine, with a concentrated palate and a long lingering and mineral finish.



# **Springfield Miss Lucy White Blend**

315

Region: Robertson

Notes: Unique blend of Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon, and Pinot Gris bursts with citrus pomelo flavors and an ample mouth feel, yet remarkably moderate in alcohol.



#### **B Vintners B de Alexandria Muscat**

490

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Perfume of rose petals and orange blossom, is well balanced with lime, litchi and pear. The delicate palate, leads you further down a path of new discovery and shows subtle tangerine that lingers. Fresh acidity caresses the palate and gives length to this special wine.



# **Usana The Runaway Pinot Gris**

495

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: The wine is nice and fresh with hints of Granny Smith apple some pear and white peach. The lees contact adds lovely texture and weight to the palate. It has good depth and Pinot Gris is very versatile with food.



#### Casal Garcia Vinho Verde

550

Region: Vinho Verde

Notes: Casal Garcia vinho verde is a white wine that presents a cítrus green wine color and a clear appearance. This is a smooth and fresh green wine with a delicate and fruity aroma, young and balanced. It's a 70-year-old brand produced by Aveleda and is easily identified by its blue label, which represents one of the magnificent embroideries of the Minho Region.



## **Thorne & Daughters Rocking Horse Cape White**

750

Region: Western Cape

Notes: Aromas of lime leaf, white peach, exotic woods, and rosemary; in the mouth, the wine starts broad and rich, resolving into a keen line of acidity supported by a gentle tannin.



#### **AA Badenhorst Family Wines Kalmoesfontein White**

1100

Region: Swartland

Notes: All five varietals contribute to this complete and well-balanced wine: spring blossoms, peach, mango and stone fruit on the nose; subtle hints of oak spice; finishes with elegance and freshness on the palate.



#### **Craven Clairette Blanche**

1500

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: The wine is not fined or filtered and only sees a tiny whiff of sulfur at bottling. A bit of a sleeping beauty, hence us insisting on decanting prior to drinking. With some air it will show pear, spice, golden apple with a core of minerality. In true Clairette fashion, it has a lovely apple skin grip on the finish.

### **Warwick The First Lady First Lady Cabernet Sauvignon Blanc**

350

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Lots of red berries and sweet black cherries on the nose, complimented by sweet vanilla and chocolate oak; smooth ripe round tannins.



# **Springfield Whole Berry Cabernet Sauvignon**

420

Region: Robertson

Notes: A velvety wine with softer tannins and classical varietal characteristics.



#### **Meinert Cabernet Sauvignon**

515

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Red berries, cherry, spicy toasty oak and liquorice on the nose; fresh and light on the palate.



#### **Hartenberg Cabernet Sauvignon**

535

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Truffle with cigar box and lead pencil, palate shows red and black fruits, vanilla oak flavors and savory, lingering tannins on the aftertaste.

# Pinot Noir



#### **Thelema Sutherland Pinot Noir**

430

Region: Elgin

Notes: Light and clean with earthy wild strawberry and raspberry flavors and a perfumed elegant finish



#### **Oak Valley Sounds Of Silence The Valley Pinot Noir**

430

Region: Elgin

Notes: The nose reveals cherries, rose petal and inviting cinnamon. The palate offers cranberry and ripe cherry Flavors with more savory notes as the wine breathes. The finish is long and refreshing thanks to the good acidity from the vintage.



Creation Pinot Noir 560

Region: Walker Bay

Notes: Delicate whiffs of violet with hints of raspberry and spice on the nose; a terroir-expressive, silky wine with delightful red berry flavors and lithe tannins on the well-balanced palate.



#### **Newton Johnson Pinot Noir**

750

Region: Hemel en Aarde Valley

Notes: Perfumed layers of red fruits; the warm, rich spice and woody notes mingle with earthy mushroom and dried flower characters. The generous and polished palate is gripped with fine, chalky tannins. Ripe raspberry fruit provides some flesh to the mid palate, with long savory liquorice flavor in the finish.

# Merlot



Villiera Merlot 245

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Aromas of cedar wood and vanilla with attractive berry fruit and concentrated flavors, rich and full on the palate with soft tannins.



Eagles Nest Merlot 395

Region: Constantia

Notes: Complex fruit, focused by bright acidity; on the palate the dark berry fruit of the nose is carried through to the taste buds and combine harmoniously for a rewarding taste sensation; juicy tannins that extend into a persistent aftertaste.



Groote Post Merlot 420

Region: Darling

Notes: Berry and plum flavors are prominent on the nose, supported by a subtle hint of mint, resulting in a wonderful flavor spectrum. A juicy mid palate is supported by soft silky tannins and ageing in oak barrels.



# **Jordan Black Magic Merlot**

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Rich in plum and berry flavors, interlaced with soft, ripe tannins and spicy oak.



#### **Thelema Estate Merlot**

540

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: This Merlot embodies a remarkable balance between smooth elegance and vibrant fruitiness, making it a true delight for the senses. Ripe red cherries and luscious plum dominate the aroma, creating an alluring entrance that promises a flavorful experience.

Region: Western Cape

Notes: Fresh, intense cherry and dark chocolate aromas. The juicy soft palate is framed by warming vanilla and touch of oak.



# Alvis drift 221 Pinotage

320

Region: Western Cape

Notes: Forward wild fruit, prune and youngberry with toasted cedar, vanilla and gun smoke; palate starts out racy, with a red fruited bright core and firm tannins, developing further complexity of sour cherry, cola, green olives and smoke.



Kaapzicht Pinotage 410

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Forward wild fruit, prune and youngberry with toasted cedar, vanilla and gun smoke palate starts out racy, with a red fruited bright core and firm tannins, developing further complexity of sour cherry, cola, green olives and smoke.



# **Meinert Printers Ink Pinotage**

455

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Full-bodied and elegant with richness on the mid-palate; emphasis on fruit flavors with soft tannins.

# Shiraz/Syrah



## **Hartenberg Doorkeeper Shiraz**

350

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Aroma displays rich spice, chocolate and violet, rich subtle palate of roasted coffee, vanilla toast with a savory aftertaste.



La Bri Syrah 445

Region: Franschhoek

Notes: Entices with an explosive mix of violets, peppermint, and thyme; entry is juicy and bright leading to a fresh palate that combines flavors of black mulberry and dark chocolate.



#### **Waterford Kevin Arnold Shiraz**

870

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Shiraz is a variety chosen for its property of expressing a sense of place, and in this instance, vineyards located in the Helderberg region of Stellenbosch. Lingering aromatics of dark plums, liquorice spice, subtly layered with earthy notes are typical characteristics.

# Other Red Variatals



#### **Rietvallei Dark Cin Cinsaut**

230

Region: Robertson

Notes: The nose reveals dark earthy black berry fruit with touches of spice and smokey nuances. The palate is intense with juicy berry fruit and hints of chocolate and spicy freshness. Beautifully rounded with gentle inviting fruit tannins and delicious, juicy, all-encompassing finish.



**Meinert La Barry Red** 

350

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Huge red fruit hit on the nose with nice warm vanilla. Velvet chocolate on the palate and strong cherry with a hint of white pepper.



#### **Winshaw Vineyards Bill Winshaw**

920

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: 66% Cabernet Franc, 17% Cabernet Sauvignon and 17% Merlot – Shows savory layers of earthy black fruit, blueberry, tilled earth, coffee beans and grilled herbs. The palate is creamy and textural, plush and fleshy, with smoky graphite, salted liquorice, sweet tobacco spice and black currant leaf.



## **Winshaw Vineyards Charles Winshaw**

920

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Another classy Cabernet Sauvignon based blend, the aromatics are rich and powerful, packed full of sweet tobacco, earthy black currant, grilled herbs, iodine and graphite spice. The palate shows great generosity and fleshy opulence with layers of black and blueberry fruits, cherry tobacco, buttered brown toast and salty liquorice on the finish.

# Saxenburg Guinea Fowl Red Blend

275

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Classical South African, Bordeaux styled blend. It is medium-bodied and approachable, but with beautiful concentration and length. Enticing notes of dark cherries, plums and spice on the nose, with soft tannins on the palate.



#### **Thelema Mountain Red**

290

Region: Western Cape

Notes: Spicy aromas of black pepper and mulberry mingle with the plum flavors of this soft and approachable wine.



## **Hartenberg Cabernet Sauvignon/Shiraz**

310

Region: Stellenbosch

Notes: Pepper and spice with luscious berry aromas; elegance and rich fruit flavours; the fruit/oak balance is stylish and has a smooth, silky finish.



Marras Grenache 330

Region: Piekenierskloof

Notes: Handpicked. Placed in small crates and cooled overnight. Destemmed and crushed the next morning. Cold soaked for 3 days, where most of the extraction was done. Partially natural fermented and matured in older oak barrels for 10 months. Ripe Cherry and wild Strawberry.



## Alvis drift 221 special cuvee red

320

Region: Western Cape

Notes: Intense black-cherry colored with youthful purple shades, this wine is medium- to full-bodied with a spicy nose, showcasing rich, ripe mulberries, red cherries and a hint of lavender. In perfect balance with its gentle, yet firm tannins, the fruit follows through on the palate, lingering with a charming, spicy finish.



#### **Rickety Bridge Foundation Red**

335

Region: Franschhoek

Notes: This intriguing blend is silky soft on the palate with succulent tannins and notes of black pepper, blackcurrant, white chocolate on the nose. Layered complexity on the nose and palate surprise with every interaction.



#### Gabriëlskloof The Blend

365

Region: Western Cape

Notes: Blackberries offer the first promise of luscious fruit, followed by hints of paprika and leather and caramel flavors, mouth feel is velvety, with complex rounded tannin grip.



Alvis drift fusion red 410

Region: Worcester

Notes: A sumptuous, complex Cape blend with intense aromas of ripe blackberries, cherries and plums, with beautifully integrated vanilla, spice and cashew nut characters. Well balanced with a firm and well-integrated tannin structure, this full-bodied wine has a lingering, fruit-driven finish and will mature for five to eight years.



### Saronsberg Seismic Rooi

445

Region: Tulbagh

Notes: Dark color with flavors of cassis, red berry, and integrated oak; tannin is firm and well balanced with a full-bodied, elegant finish.



#### Klein Constantia Red Blend

1035

Region: Constantia

Notes: Intense ruby red in appearance. The nose offers aromas of cassis with subtle herbaceous and floral undertones. The palate is refined, rich and balanced with bold tannins and an elegant backbone. Flavors of blackberries and cigar box follow concluding with a long savory finish.

Notes: Robust with ripe black cherry, plum and mulberry whiffs; hints of cigar and cedar wood.

Notes: Complex bouquet of fruit with red plum and blackberries dominant with further notes of black cherry and mulberry. Aniseed and notes of dried oregano add even more intrigue to the wine. It is well supported by grippy powdery tannins which lead to a lingering fruity finish. 51% Cabernet Franc 34% Cabernet Sauvignon 15% Merlot
